Training and Certification Opportunity in Manitoba

For experienced teachers it helps bring many themes together in a way that helps them move to the next level. For all teachers it helps re-assure risk managers that students will be well taken care of.
- <u>Project Wild</u> is a well-known curriculum for teaching a wide range of ecological material to young people though activity and experimentation.
